Vaccaro explained to the Trustees that in 2019 there was a change in the law that allows the Township to request an additional \$5.00 for the Vehicle License Tax. He stated that he is not looking for any action to be taken, just making the Trustees aware. Vaccaro said that Jackson Township is currently at \$15.00. Hawke responded that he doesn't think there is a reason to request the additional tax and feels the Township is in line with others in the area. Pizzino added that the budget has been set for this year and there are enough funds available, so he also does not see the need to request the additional tax. Thomas agreed. Gonzalez added that the Board has several opportunities to add taxes like this, including cable franchise fees, but they do not. They have stuck with the taxpayers choices in terms of voted levies and have not added hidden taxes and he commends them for that.
