If the owner fails to meet this obligation within the five-day period, or the subsequent 30 day periods, the Township will mow at \$150.00 per hour with a \$400.00 minimum charge per lot or parcel. As stated in our prior courtesy letter to you, pursuant to ORC Sections 5579.06 and 5579.07, a \$150.00 administrative fee per lot or parcel will be placed on your tax duplicate.
